

Municipality of Norfolk Treherne

2019 TAXATION BY-LAW
By-Law No. 52-2019

Being a by-law of the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne for the purpose of establishing taxation rates for the Municipality for the year 2019.

WHEREAS Section 304 (1) of The Municipal Act states that no later than May 15 of each year, after adopting its operating budget for the year, a council must by by-law;

- (a) set a rate or rates of tax sufficient to raise
 - (i) the revenue to be raised by property taxes as set out in the operating budget, and
 - (ii) the revenue to be raised in the year to pay for a local improvement or special service and to pay the requisitions payable by the municipality;
- (b) impose taxes
 - (i) in accordance with the tax rate or rates set under clause (a) on the portioned value of each assessable property in the municipality that is liable under *The Municipal Assessment Act* to that tax, and
 - (ii) where the tax is in respect of a local improvement or special service, in accordance with the local improvement or special service by-law; and
- (c) set a due date for payment of the taxes.

AND WHEREAS the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne has adopted a financial plan as required under Section 162 (1) for the year 2019.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne in open council duly assembled as follows;

1. That the following respective rates of so much on the dollar be and it is hereby levied for the year 2019 upon the assessed value of all rateable property in the municipality respectively liable, therefore according to the latest revised assessment roll of general property thereof, to raise the sums required for the fiscal purposes of the corporation.


a) That the following respective foundation and special mill rates of so many mills on the dollar levied for education and school purposes.

- b) A special rate of 5.907 mills on the dollar be and hereby is levied on all properties included in the Special Services Plan No. 1-2019 to raise a sum of \$125,998.67 to offset operating costs for recreation, snow removal and grass and weed control for the urban community of Treherne.
- c) A special rate of \$75.00 per parcel be applied to all the properties included in Special Services Plan No. 1-2016, By-Law No. 17-2016 to raise a sum of \$30,675.00 to offset operating costs for fire protection provided by the Treherne – South Norfolk Fire Department.
- d) A special rate of \$64.61 per unit be applied to all the properties included in (RM of South Norfolk) By-Law No. 2439/2002 for the Rathwell Recreation District to raise a sum \$11,177.53.
- e) An annual special services tax of \$160.54 per property be levied upon all properties included in (RM of South Norfolk) By-Law No. 2478/2009 for the Notre Dame Recreation Area to raise a sum of \$11,879.96.
- f) An annual special services tax of \$192.00 per property be levied upon all properties included in (RM of South Norfolk) By-Law No. 2479/2009 for the Treherne Recreation Area to raise a sum of \$ 24,000.00.
- g) A special rate of \$250.00 per property be levied upon all properties included in By-Law No.2504/2011 for the Rathwell Utility Operating Support Services area to raise a sum of \$20,500.00.
- h) A special rate of \$44.00 per parcel be applied to all the properties included in Special Services Plan No. 2, (Town of Treherne) By-Law No. 876/2009 to raise the sum of \$14,256.00 for Treherne Aquatic Centre Support Service Area.
- i) A general rate of 0.106 mills on the dollar to raise \$10,019.43 is hereby levied for the year 2019 upon the assessed value of all the rateable property in the special district for the LaSalle Redboine Conservation District.
- j) A special rate of \$144.10 per parcel for (RM of South Norfolk) Local Improvement Utility Plan No. 2004 for the Rathwell water plant upgrade to raise the sum of \$8,069.60 for payment of monies payable upon debentures issued under By-Law No. 2461/2007.

- k) A special rate of \$76.92 per parcel for Local Improvement Plan No. Treherne Utility 1-2015 for the Treherne water main renewal and sewer repairs to raise the sum of \$20,383.80 for payment of monies payable upon debentures issued under By-law No. 38-2017.
- l) A general rate of 12.575 mills on the dollar be and hereby is levied for the year 2019 upon the rateable property in the Municipality liable therefore according to the latest revised general property assessment rolls thereof to provide for the payment of the amounts estimated as required for the general controllable purposes of the corporation.
2. (a) That all taxes and rates imposed and levied in the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne for the year 2019, shall be deemed to have been imposed and to be due and payable at par on **31st day of October A.D. 2019.**
- b) That a penalty of one percent (1%) per month shall be added to all unpaid taxes on the 1st day of November 2019, and a like penalty on the first day of each and every month thereafter until paid.
- c) That the following discounts be allowed:
- i. All current taxes paid in the month of June, will receive a 2% discount,
 - ii. All current taxes paid in the month of July, will receive a 1.5% discount,
 - iii. All current taxes paid in the month of August, will receive a 1% discount,
 - iv. All current taxes paid in the month of September, will receive a .5% discount.
