Municipality of Norfolk Treherne FIRE PROTECTION SUPPORT SERVICE

By-Law No. 17-2016

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne to establish a rate for fire protection services as a special service in the urban community of Treherne, Ward 3 for the years 2016 to 2020, inclusive.

WHEREAS Section 312 of the Municipal Act states in part:

If approved by by-law, a municipality may provide, as a special service to all or part of a municipality, one or more of the following:

(i) fire and police protection services;

AND WHEREAS subsection 320(1) of *The Municipal Act* provides as follows: Subject to subsections (2) to (6) and subsection 321(4), a council may by by-law:

- (a) approve the local improvement or special service as set out in the plan or proposal; and
- (b) authorize the municipality to impose taxes as set out in the plan or proposal.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne has prepared Special Services Plan No. 1-2016 to establish a rate for fire protection services as a special service pursuant to Part 10 of *The Municipal Act*;

AND WHEREAS the requirements as prescribed in section 318, 319, and 320 of *The Municipal Act* have been complied with;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne duly assembled enacts as follows:

- That pursuant to subsection 320(1) of *The Municipal Act*, the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne approves Special Services Plan No. 1-2016 "Fire Protection Support Service" attached hereto as Schedule "A".
- 2. That the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne levy an annual special service tax upon all taxable, grant in lieu, and exempt properties within the urban community of Treherne, Ward 3 from the year 2016 to 2020 as hereto attached as Schedule "B".

SCHEDULE "A"

to BY-LAW NO. 17-2016 Special Services Plan No. 1-2016

Fire Protection Support Service

Pursuant to Section 314 of The Municipal Act

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A Proposed Service:

The intent of this special service plan is to establish a special service levy to offset fire protection costs provided by the Treherne-South Norfolk Fire Department.

Under By-Law No. 890/2011 the Town of Treherne shifted the cost of this service from the Town's general mill rate to a special service per parcel rate. The Town of Treherne and the Rural Municipality of South Norfolk amalgamated effective January 1, 2015 to form the Municipality of Norfolk Treherne. The Town of Treherne and Rural Municipality of South Norfolk split equally all costs to operate the Treherne – South Norfolk Fire Department.

Under this Plan as By-Law No. 890/2011 will expire at the end of 2015, Council is proposing to continue the per parcel levy on the urban community of Treherne, Ward 3 (formerly the Town of Treherne) for the years 2016 to 2020.

B Area of the Municipality for the Special Service Tax:

The Special Service Tax will be levied on all taxable, grant in lieu and otherwise exempt properties within the urban community of Treherne, Ward 3 as described in Schedule "B" attached hereto.

C Estimated Cost of Service:

In 2015 the actual amount levied was \$59.24 on each parcel of land; raising a total of \$25,177.00 for 2015.

The estimated special service costs for the years 2016 to 2020 is a minimum of \$25,358 to a maximum of \$30,675 per year.

D Method and Rate to Calculate the Special Service Tax:

The method of taxation to be used to calculate the special service tax will be a flat rate equally applied to each parcel of land included in the Fire Protection Support Service area.

The rate will be a minimum of \$62.00 to a maximum of \$75.00 on each eligible property. All property and rates are detailed on Schedule "B" attached.
